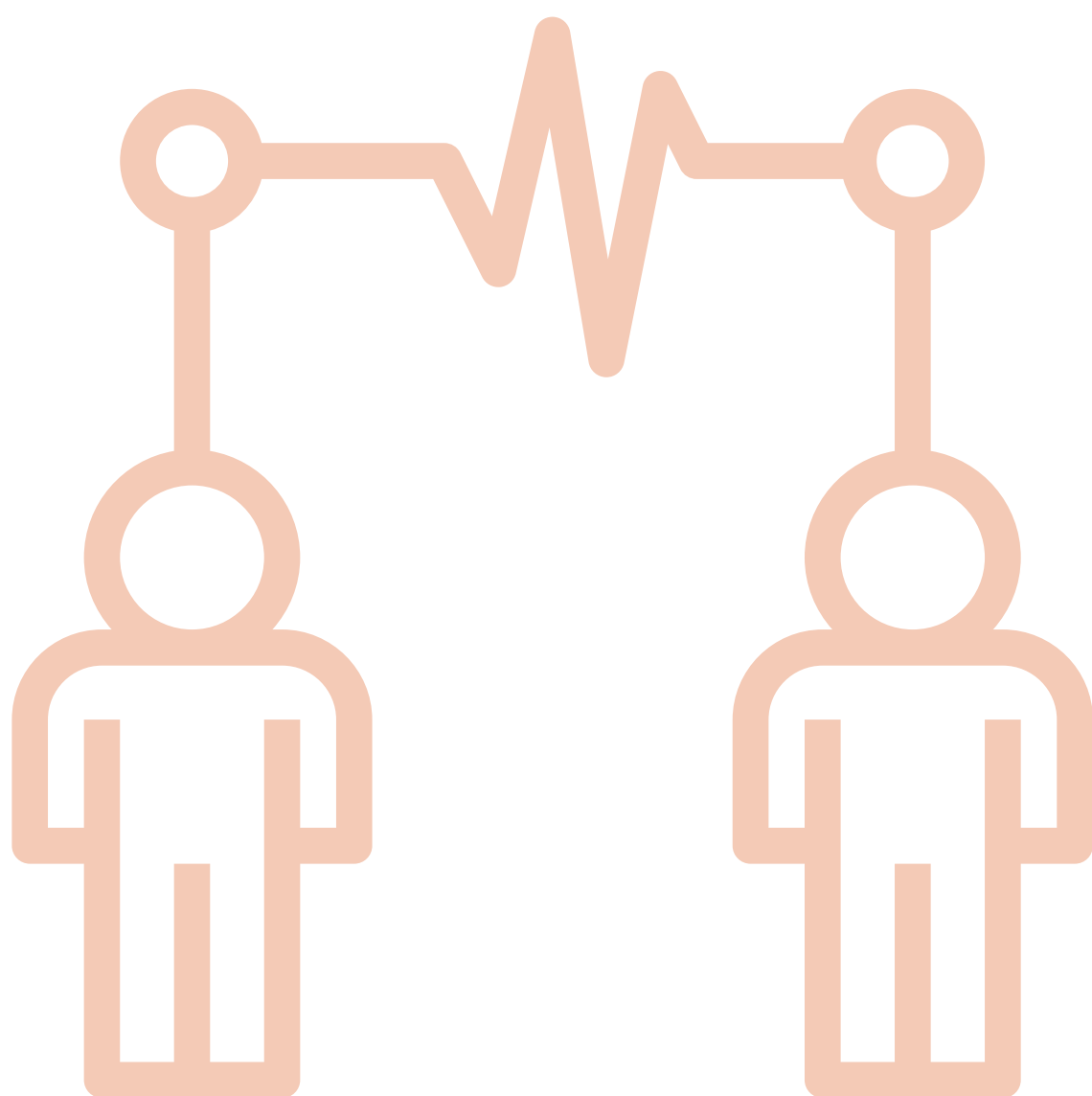

# EXERCISE 1

## GLOSSARY - SŁOWNICZEK

A1/A2

uśmiech - **a smirk**

herbatnik - **a biscuit**

konkurs - **a competition**

prawnik - **a lawyer**

pozwalać - **to allow**

agent nieruchomości - **an estate agent**

wykrywać - **to detect**

nieuczciwy - **dishonest**

nieszkodliwy - **inoffensive**

unikać - **to avoid**

ukrywać - **to hide**

zyskać przewagę - **to gain an advantage**

**fib** - small inoffensive lie - *kłamstewko*

**white lie** - small lie, told to avoid upsetting someone - *niewinne kłamstwo*

**deceive** - try to hide something by tricking people to gain an advantage - *oszukać*

**at the heart** - most important or essential part - *w samym środku, w samym sercu czegoś*

**response latency** - a term used in psychology to describe the time taken between a stimulus or question and a response to it - *czas odpowiedzi*

**porkies** - informal word for lies - *ściemy*
