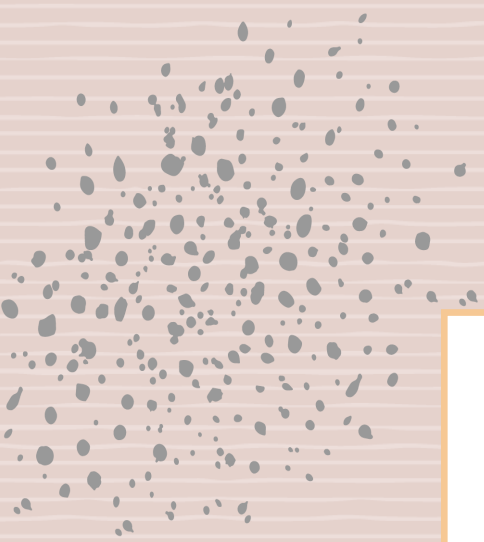

## Present Perfect

- nie wiemy kiedy
- jeśli widać skutek
- mówimy ile sztuk, ile razy
- just, already, yet
- ever, never, before, doświadczenia
- lately, recently
- for, since (w znaczeniu od)
- this afternoon, month, year, jeśli nadal trwa
- today, the first/second/third time

## Past Simple

- wiemy, kiedy, czasem wynika to z kontekstu np. opowieści lub z info w poprzednim zdaniu
- ważny jest czas wykonania czynności
- pytamy, kiedy coś się wydarzyło
- last Monday, last week etc
- yesterday, ago,
- when I was 12, the other day
- for (w przez, okres skończony)
- this afternoon, jak już jest wieczór
- in 2019

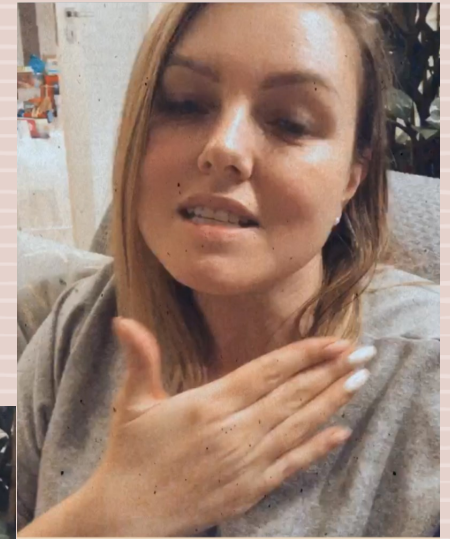

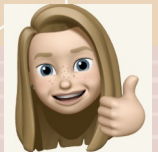
