

Present Perfect	Past Simple
- nie wiemy kiedy	<ul> <li>wiemy, kiedy, czasem wynika to z kontekstu np. opowieści lub z info w poprzednim zdaniu</li> </ul>
- jeśli widać skutek	<ul> <li>ważny jest czas wykonania czynno- ści</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>mówimy ile sztuk, ile razy</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>pytamy, kiedy coś się wydarzyło</li> </ul>
- just, already, yet	- last Monday, last week etc
ever, never, before, doświadczenia	- yesterday, ago,
- lately, recently	- when I was 12, the other day
- for, since (w znaczeniu od)	- for (w przez, okres skończony)
- this afternoon, month, year, jeśli na- dal trwa	- this afternoon, jak już jest wieczór






